## Laila del Monte

Animal Communicator Laila del Monte spent her formative years on the Balearic Island of Formentera, Spain and Paris. Laila now lives in Los Angeles, and often travels to Europe teaching animal communication workshops in France, Italy and Switzerland. Laila is consulted to communicate with "problem horses" and healing of sick and injured animals. She has worked for riders of the French national jumping team and has given a workshop for Michel Robert in France. Her book on animal communication will be published in January.

## Patrick Allori

Horseman and Trainer Patrick Allori was born of an Italian mother and a Cheyenne father. His father was intent on Patrick spending as much time as possible on the Northern Cheyenne reservation to understand his roots and discover the native horse relationship. He was also an open rider in reining (western show) for twenty years. Today, Patrick lives in Switzerland, gives workshops throughout Europe and works with horses with personality and emotional disorders. He also breaks young horses according to the Cheyenne tradition. He has worked with riders of such caliber as Patrice Delaveau, Eric Levallois, Florian Angot, Michel Hecart (all of them from the French national jumping team) and Antonella Joannou (classic dressage, Swiss-Romande champion).
